### A Real Hero

What is a "hero" for you? Terry Fox was born on July 28, 1958 in Canada. He played different sports in high school and went to university to study physical education. He had to stop his studies in 1977 when the doctor discovered that he had bone cancer. At that time, he was just seventeen. Unfortunately, after that, his right leg was amputated above his knee. Without a leg, it seemed he couldn't enjoy running anymore. But giving up was the last thing he would do. He decided to run across Canada. His plan was to let other people know more about the suffering of cancer patients and also raise money for them. Then, to prepare for his plan, he spent 18 months running thousands of kilometers.

On April 20th, 1980, Terry was fitted with an artificial leg and he started his run. It was a very difficult run, but he just made up his mind to do it. It didn't take him much time to catch the media's eye. The reporters started to report on the whole story. More and more people were gathering along the way to cheer and donated money to his dream.

After 143 days, Terry had finished 5,373 kilometers, but he could not go any further. He got sicker day after day. Sadly, he passed away on June 28, 1981. But it was not the end of his dream. He once said, "Being self-centered is not the way to live. The answer is to try and help others. Even if I don't finish, we need others to continue. It's got to keep going without me." His story continues to inspire people around the world. Terry Fox Runs still take place in over 9000 schools across Canada and other counties every year.


